## Admission Policy

1. Applicants must be graduates of an accredited high school or provide evidence of established equivalency of high school through the General Education Development Test (G.E.D.)
2. A high school transcript or official report of G.E.D. test results is required.
3. Applicants should have a 2.0 accumulative point hour. Applicants should have satisfactorily completed at least one course in science. Biology is recommended.
4. A satisfactory grade in Math is required. Algebra is recommended.
5. Previous college credits will be evaluated on an individual basis.

## Admission Process

1. Application Procedure: A signed and completed application and payment of the \$95 non-refundable application fee, along with a copy of high school transcript or GED. Return your application by mail or in person.
2. Pre-entrance Testing: Applicants are required to take the TEAS V and the WorkKeys exams. Review texts are optional and available for purchase.
3. Interview/Information Session with the Program Manager is required.
4. Notification of Admissions - Pay the non-refundable \$500 admissions fee in full.
5. Completion of Pre-requisite classes

  - Math for Meds
  - Computer class, if applicable
  - CPR Card
