Welding is used in a wide variety of industries. It's a challenging, yet rewarding career, that is in high demand.

This 650-hour program provides training in a broad range of welding skills. Students are expected to be able to stand for long periods of time, be able to lift up to 50 pounds, and have correctable vision.

Past graduates of this program have found employment with local manufacturing and service providers.

- GTAW—Gas Tungsten Arc Welding TIG (91 hours)

- Employability Job Search Techniques (13 hours)

The program is 5 months in length and the class schedule is Monday through Friday 8:30am-3:30pm.

Students will be given the opportunity to test for American Welding Society (AWS) certifications and is based on certifying criteria established:

- AWS Certified Welder D1.1 4G SMAW

- AWS Certified Welder D1.6 3F GTAW
