Updates:

1. We will not be having **Final Exams** this year for any of our classes.
2. If a student is in a **CCP course** they are required by their college to complete a final exam.
3. **Prom** has been cancelled for this year. Governor's order to avoid mass gatherings and be able to practice social distancing appropriately.
4. **Semester two grades** will be the average from the 3rd quarter and 4th quarter grade.
5. We will continue to follow the original **school calendar**.
6. **Seniors** last day of school is Tuesday, May 12. **Underclassmen's** last day of school is Thursday, May 21st.
7. **Senior Recognition** - we will be completing a video and posting on social media. Students will also be given a video keepsake as well as a t-shirt.
