ACTION PLAN

In an effort to secure the health and safety of our students and staff, while at the same time following the mission of Tri-Rivers, the Administration will implement the following action plan.

Current Situation: The Tri-Rivers/Marion General Hospital School of Paramedicine Training Programs is currently conducting classes for EMR, EMT and Paramedicine.

- The EMR class has 5 students enrolled. This class is a part of professional development funded by Nucor Company. This class meets every Friday from 8a.m.-2 p.m. The class started on 2/7/2020 and scheduled to conclude on 5/16/2020.
- The EMT class started with 13 students; One student was dismissed due to attendance issues. This class meets every Tuesday and Thursday from 5 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. and one Saturday a month from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. The class started 1/21/2020 and is scheduled to conclude 5/12/2020.
- The Paramedicine program has 13 students enrolled. The class started 7/13/2019 and scheduled to conclude on 6/6/20. The program curriculum plan is divided into four (4) quarters of traditional face to face class room, skills lab instructions and testing, and clinical and field experiences/rotations; quarter IV, the last and final quarter, is dedicated for Field Internship. The current cohort of 13 students are now in the middle of Quarter III of the program. Many students are on track with clinical and field hours and patient experience skills and procedures. Although, many of the Field (pre-hospital) agencies closed their doors to students; OhioHealth Marion General Hospital continued to allow students to participate in clinical Precepted led experiences. Additionally, since all 13 students are affiliated with 1 or more Field Agencies, students continue to participate in Field Precepted rotations. The challenge is the delivery of didactic portion and hands on psychomotor learning.

General Plan

March 16-20:

March 23-29:

- All classes will be held via remote instructions.
- Clinical and Field rotations for **Paramedicine** will continue if clinical partners continue to allow it.
- Paramedic Students who are associated with approved (contracted) field or prehospital agencies will continue to complete their rotations adhering to the policies and procedures as specified in the student and clinical handbook consistent with Chapter 4765-7 of Ohio Administrative Code (AOC).

April 13:

If permitted as directed by Ohio Law and regulating agencies – The Ohio Governor's Office.

- Face to face classes, skills lab and practicum will resume.
- All clinical rotation and preceptorships will continue if clinical partners continue to allow it.
- All other regular scheduled classes including pre-requisites will resume as originally planned.
