1. What can I wear the first day of school?

Usually, our students are in uniform from Day 1; however, this year is unusual as you know. Many of you haven't even ordered uniforms. So we will be flexible the first few weeks of school. We just ask that you dress "school appropriate." All students will be receiving 2 FREE Tri-Rivers T-shirts the first week. New students will also receive an additional "Welcome T-shirt."

2. How do I order my uniforms since we didn't have Great Start?

4. What is an A/B Schedule?

Currently, we are planning to start school on an A/B Schedule. With an A/B Schedule, half of our students are here one day and the other half the next day. Group A are students with last names starting with A through L. Group B are students with last names starting with M through Z. Students will have assignments for the days they are home. 5. What day is the start up day currently?

As of August 6, 2020, the plan is to start with—

- the A Group (students with last names starting with A through L) on Tuesday, September 1, 2020.
- the B Group (students with last names starting with M through Z) on Wednesday, September 2, 2020

6. Why haven't I been receiving the emails and text messages from Tri-Rivers Principal Chris Solis with updates and/or why didn't I receive a packet in the mail?

If you aren't receiving updates from Principal Solis and/or you didn't get a packet in the mail, it may be because you have a new address or phone number. **Be sure to fill in all of your information on Final Forms.** (There is a letter enclosed explaining how to do that if you haven't already. You can also call your school counselor and let her know (see enclosed flyer with your Tri-Rivers school counselors' contact information)

7. I don't understand how to fill in Final Forms and/or how to access it?

8. What time do I have to be to Tri-Rivers?

9. What about transportation?

You need to check with your home school. Typically, your home school provides transportation to Tri-Rivers even when they are closed and we are open. Some schools do require group stops or they only transport from the school. But, please connect with them directly to get details.

10. How do I set up my health plan with Tri-Rivers School Nurse?

First, be sure to fill in the health forms on Final Forms. You also need to connect with Nurse Pemberton if you have medical conditions or need to take medication during school. Call her at 740-389-8519 or email her at cpemberton@tririvers.com There is a flyer enclosed with more details.

11. What about my immunizations?

Your immunizations must be up to date. You can visit the Marion Public Health Clinic, 9am to 3:30pm on Mondays or Wednesdays. Call for an appointment: 740-387-6520. They are located at 181 S. Main St, Marion, OH. You will need your date of birth, insurance, and if under 18 years of age, a parent must attend or send a note.

12. What about College Credit Plus (CCP)?

13. My program requires a BCI/FBI check.

Since we canceled *Great Start 2020*, any necessary BCI/FBI checks required for programs will be completed once we start school. Your instructors will have information.
