






Planning for your health & safety, well-being and educational success!

The circumstances resulting from the pandemic have prompted Tri-Rivers to create three educational plans. At Tri-Rivers we believe hands-on learning is the best way to learn and that is always our goal. Following Ohio Guidelines, Tri-Rivers is implementing a three-plan strategy for the 2020-2021 school year to ensure that we are prepared to provide our students the best learning opportunities while focusing on their health & safety.

-  **When our area is Level 1 (yellow) or Level 2 (orange),** we will provide daily hands-on, face-to-face learning on the Tri-Rivers campus, while exercising safety precautions and protocols.
-  **When our area is Level 3 (red),** we will exercise caution and run an ***A/B Schedule where half of our students are here one day and the other half the next day (we will continue to emphasize quality and hands-on).**
-  **When it's Level 4 (purple),** we will go to all on-line learning using techniques that are hands-on, interactive and visual—Zoom, Swivl, Canvas, Google, etc.

Updated!!!! August 5, 2020—Tri-Rivers 2020-2021 School Reset and RESTART Schedule:

- September 1 (Tuesday)—We will run an A/B Schedule* (half of our students are here one day; the other half the next day) Group A will report today—Students With Last Names Starting with A through L
- September 2 (Wednesday)—A/B Schedule* (half of our students are here one day; the other half the next day) Group B Reports Today—Students With Last Names Starting with M through Z
- Sept. 3, 4, 8, 9, 10 and 11 we will continue to run an *A/B Schedule—Red/Level 3.

We will then assess the situation going forward.

Ohio Guidelines	Level 1—Public Emergency: active exposure and spread Level 2—Public Emergency: increased exposure and spread. Exercise high degree of caution.	Level 3—Public Emergency: very high exposure and spread. Limit activities as much as possible.	Level 4—Public Emergency: severe exposure and spread. Only leave home for supplies and services.
