The **Patient Care Technician Program** is designed to prepare students with basic entry-level courses in health care in order to provide safe, direct care for clients in a variety of health care settings. The successful candidate has the option to achieve certification in CPR, Nurse Aide, Phlebotomy, EKG, Electronic Health Records, Billing & Coding, Patient Care Technician, Medical Administrative Assistant, and Clinical Medical Assistant. Testing is provided by The National Healthcareer™ Association and is optional. *The PCT program provides the pre-requisite support courses for the Practical Nursing Program.*

The program is 9 months in length (August through May) and is full-time.

The program is divided into 4 quarters:

-Quarter I: Learning Strategies, ComTech, Medical Terminology, Microsoft Word, CPR/First Aid, Math for Meds

-Quarter II: Nurse Aide, Electronic Health Records/Medical Administrative Assistant, Microsoft PowerPoint, Anatomy and Physiology

-Quarter III: Medical Coding, EKG, Phlebotomy/Lab

-Quarter IV: Medical Billing, Health Care Skills/Pharmacology, Externship, Resume Microsoft Excel

Total Program Hours = 718

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Program applicants must submit or complete the following:

-Submit a completed application form and application fee.

-Complete WorkKeys® testing with a score of 4 or greater for each of the 3 tests.

-Submit official transcripts from high school or proof of successful completion of General Equivalency Diploma (GED).

Application deadline is July 1st for August admission.
