## EMT-Emergency Medical Technician

The EMT program is 170 hours (154 classroom, 10 Clinical/Field Experience, 6 Certification Testing) and follows the U.S. Department of Transportation and Ohio Division of EMS guidelines. Certification as an Ohio EMT is contingent upon successful completion of the course requirements and passing the National Registry Practical and Written Examination.

Class schedule is provided in advance with class 2 evenings per week (5-9:30pm) and 1 & 3 Saturdays per month (8am-4pm) with scheduled breaks. The program is provided 2 times per year.

-Submit a completed application form and application fee.

-Complete WorkKeys® testing with a score of 4 or greater for Workplace Documents.

## Tri-Rivers / Marion General Hospital School of Paramedicine

The Paramedicine program is 900+ hours (500 didactic & lab, 400 minimum competency-based clinical hours) provides current EMTs the opportunity to advance their skills with focused training in providing emergency care, including, professionalism, communication, as well as specific situational care including cardiac arrest, burns, injuries, rescue operations, and trauma. Certification as an Ohio Paramedic is contingent upon successful completion of the course requirements and passing the National Registry Practical and Written Examination.

Class schedule is provided in advance with class scheduled on duty days (2-3days per week) from 8am-4pm with scheduled breaks.

-Submit a completed application form and application fee.

-Complete WorkKeys® testing with a score of 4 or greater for each of the 3 tests.
