Dear Tri-Rivers Families,

Today we had approximately a dozen students come to the nurse's office that were sent home ill. To take precautionary measures we are pressing pause to evaluate the safety of staff and students and we will be completing a deep clean tomorrow Friday, October 2, 2020. Students will be working remotely tomorrow.

We will follow up with all students that went home to confirm if testing is needed. Once we have any test results we will work with community health officials to follow up if necessary. If any changes become necessary to next week's school schedule, we will notify students and parents over the weekend.

We are working alongside Marion Public Health (MPH) to promote the health and safety of our students. We will adhere to the following guidelines:

- School employees & students will continue to use appropriate PPE/practice social distancing and perform hand hygiene. **When the 6' social distance recommendation can't be accomplished within the classroom settings, we will add additional individual barriers to protect students.**
- Quarantine will be required of the individual testing positive for COVID-19, as well as any staff or student that MPH has determined to have been in Close Contact with that individual.
- For any student or staff member identified, details regarding required quarantine will be provided by MPH.

Please know that the health and safety of our students, staff and families is our top priority. We will continue to do all we can to provide you with information and follow our policies and procedures to prevent community spread. Thanks for all that you are doing to help us.
