The Paramedicine program is 900+ hours (500 didactic & lab, 400 minimum competency-based clinical hours) provides current EMTs the opportunity to advance their skills with focused training in providing emergency care, including, professionalism, communication, as well as specific situational care including cardiac arrest, burns, injuries, rescue operations, and trauma.

Certification as an Ohio Paramedic is contingent upon successful completion of the course requirements and passing the National Registry Practical and Written Examination.

Class schedule is provided in advance with class scheduled on duty days (2-3 days per week) from 8am-4pm with scheduled breaks.
