**This program is 9 months in length
(August through May) and is full-time.**

The program is divided into 4 quarters:

- **Quarter I:** Learning Strategies, ComTech, Medical Terminology, Microsoft Word, CPR/First Aid, Math for Meds
- **Quarter II:** Nurse Aide, Electronic Health Records/Medical Administrative Assistant, Microsoft PowerPoint, Anatomy and Physiology
- **Quarter III:** EKG, Pharmacology, Phlebotomy/Lab
- **Quarter IV:** Health Care Skills/ Pharmacology, Externship, Resume, Microsoft Excel, National Healthcareer Association (NHA) Test prep
